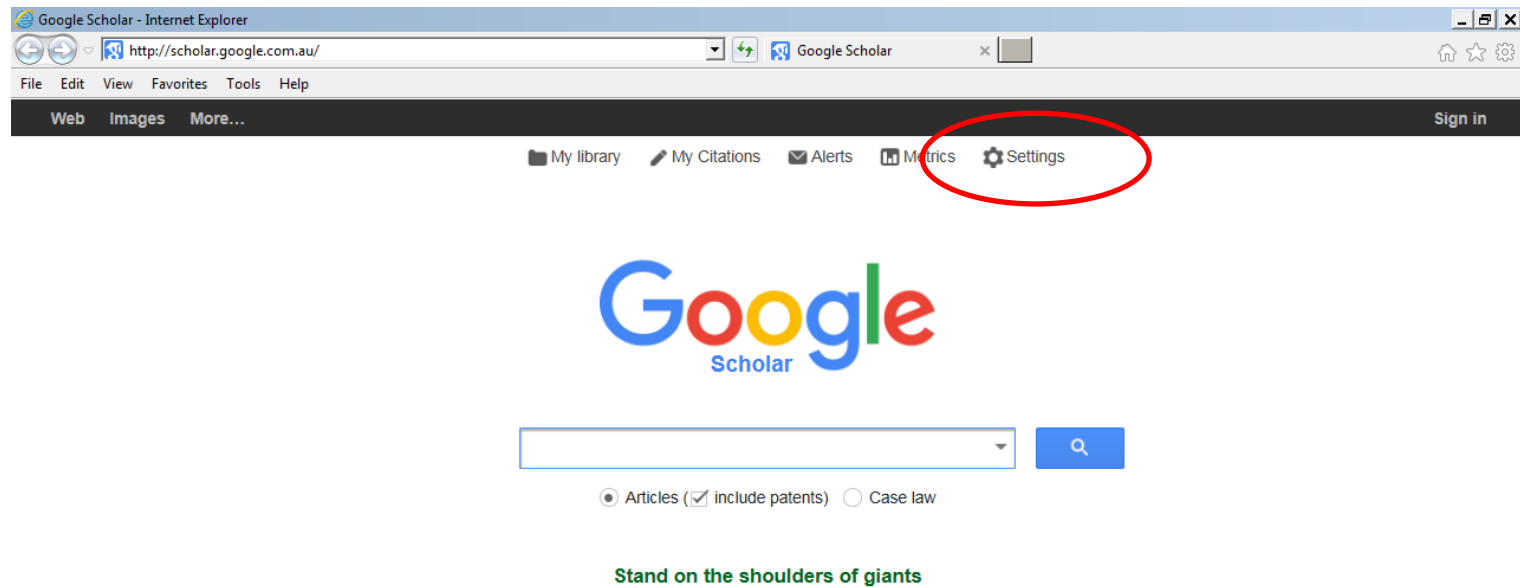
How to get to full text journal articles via Google Scholar

- Click on **Settings**



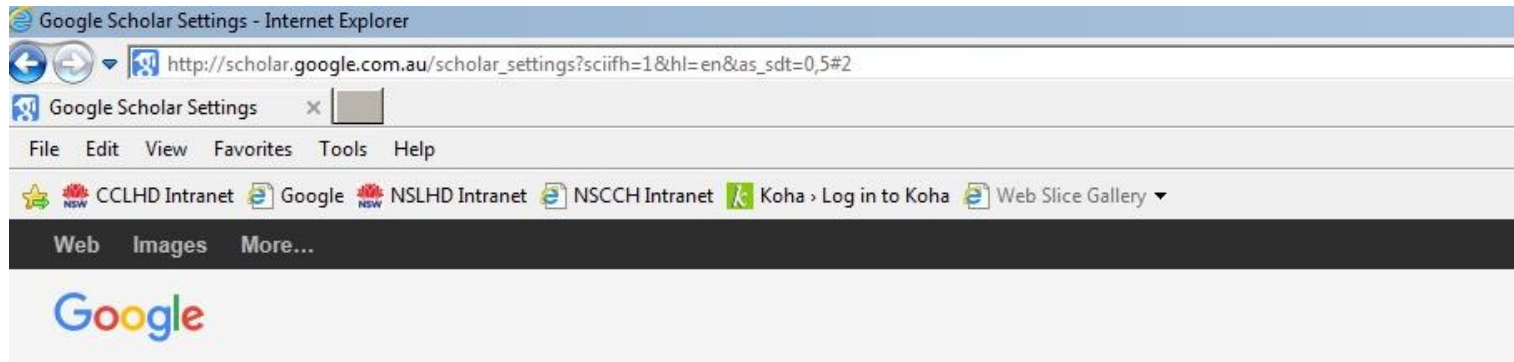
- Click on **Library Links**

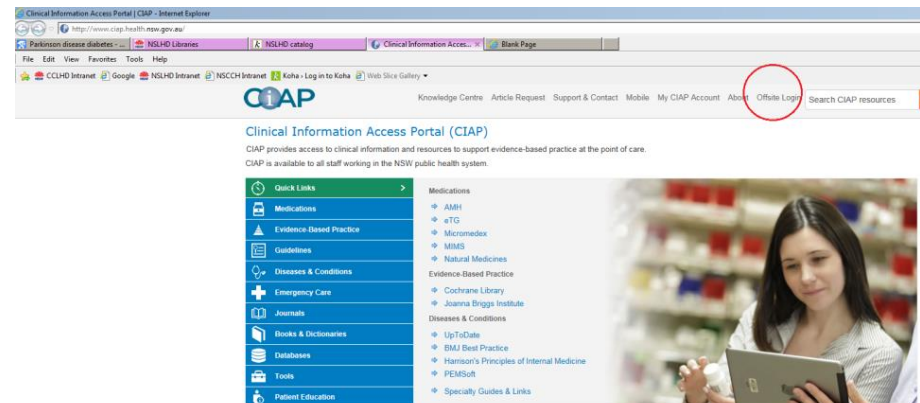
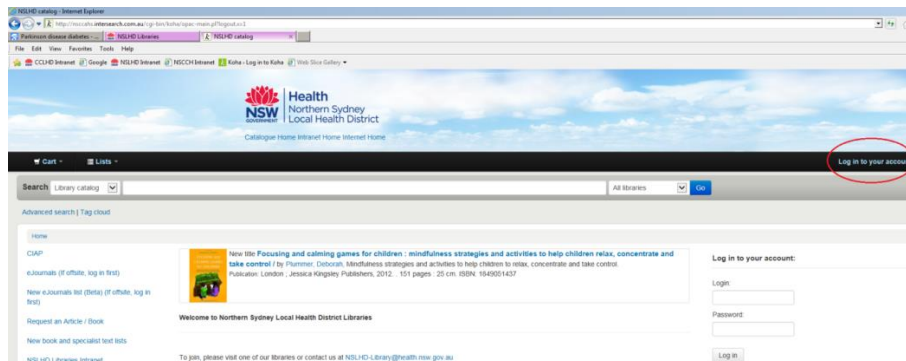

To look up articles from home, you need to join the NSLHD Libraries and have a current CIAP account.


- Login to the [Library Catalogue](#)
